

General Information

Arrival/Departure: Youth camps run from Sunday to Saturday (except for Primary or specialty camps). Check-in for all camps begins at 2PM on opening day. **No registrations will be taken before 2PM.** All youth camps end with breakfast on closing day. Please arrange to pick up campers by 10AM on closing day.

Parents: All special requests, late arrivals or early pickup arrangements have to be made prior to opening day of camp.

Contacting campers: All camper mail should be sent directly to: Camp Tamarack, E879 Golke Rd., Waupaca, WI 54981. Phone number for EMERGENCY CONTACT ONLY 715-281-2267. There are no phones available for camper's personal use and cell phones will be confiscated as we want campers to immerse in the program. DO NOT send email greetings.

Things to bring: Bible, notebook, pen, bedding, pillow, toiletries, towels, washcloth, soap, suitable clothes for day and night, rain gear, appropriate swimwear (no bikinis), flashlight, camera, musical instrument, sun screen and insect repellent.

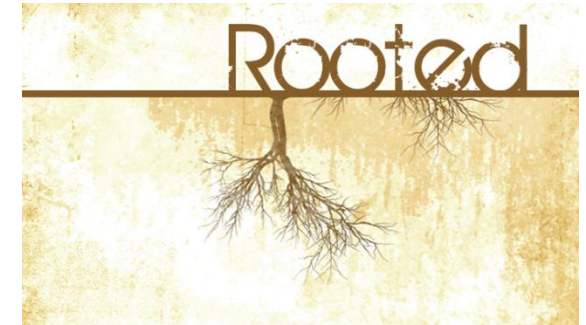

Spending money: Some needed for canteen and craft items (\$20-\$25 recommended). There is a minimal cost for most items. Canteen snack purchases are limited. T-shirts, sweatshirts, postcards and stamps are available, batteries are not.

Camp Standards

Each camper is expected to enter into the total camp program in accordance with guidelines established by the ABC/WI Camping Commission. No camper will be discriminated against because of race, sex, color, age, national origin, or handicap.

Discounts and Camperships

There are a number of ways to cut your costs in going o camp, and you are urged to take advantage of all you can. The Early Bird Discount applies to all ABC/WI sponsored camps. The other discounts and camper scholarships apply to Youth Camps only. **Registration Deposit is not refundable**, however additional fees paid are refundable two weeks prior to camp.

Early Bird Discount

A \$15 discount will be credited to registrations postmarked by April 30. Any additional discounts will be subtracted from total after each discount.

Family Discount

The oldest camper from each family pays the usual fee with the second receiving a \$15 discount. All remaining family youth campers will receive an additional \$10. (ex: 2nd = \$15, 3rd = \$25, 4th = \$35, etc.). To receive these discounts, all registrations for your family must be received in the same envelope or at the same time via the web with a note added in comments.

Please make every attempt to register as soon as possible—there is no guarantee of space or resources for late registrations.
