

DIRECTIONS:

Take Hwy 54W to County Hwy Q (there is a little Farmington Town Hall on the Corner.) Turn South onto Q for about ¾ of a mile.

When the road takes a sharp turn to the left, turn right on to Golke Rd. Camp Tamarack is on your immediate left.



Drive all the way into camp and park in area designated. Registration will take place, beginning at 2:00 p.m., in open air shelter in good weather or in John Gray Lodge in poor weather. Please do not bring any pets past the registration area/Pavilion or leave them in cars.

GENERAL INFORMATION



Arrival/Departure: Note that camps run from Sunday to Saturday this year (except Primary Camp). **Check-in for all camps begins at 2:00 p.m. on opening day.** **No registrations will be taken before 2:00 p.m.** All camps end with breakfast on closing day. Please arrange to pick up campers between 10-10:30 a.m. on closing day. **Please make sure you check your child out at the canteen before leaving the grounds.**

Things to bring: Bible, notebook, pen, bedding, pillow, toiletries, towels, washcloth, soap, suitable clothes for day & evening, rain gear, appropriate swimwear, flashlight, camera, sun screen and insect repellent and masks. Please mark all items with camper name.

Things to leave at home: Radios, electronic games, iPods/iPads/tablets, cell phones, TVs, roller blades, scooters or bikes, electric blankets, snacks, pets and valuables. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Articles left behind will be donated to charity if not called for in 10 days. Modest clothing is encouraged.

Spending money: Canteen is offered twice per day, except at Primary camp. Most of the canteen items are \$0.75 with a limit of two per canteen. Craft items range from \$0.30 to \$2.00. Canteen money is put into an account for the camper and unused monies are returned at check-out or may be donated.

Camp Standards: Each camper is expected to enter into the total camp program in accordance with guidelines established by the ABC-WI governing board. In the operation of this camp, no child will be discriminated against because of race, sex, color, age, national origin or handicap.
