

## Camp Tamarack Rates 2024

### Arthur E. Basile Retreat Center – includes full galley kitchen

\$50/person/Night

Linens available for \$15/person

### The John Gray Lodge Upper Level

Dining Hall only - \$60.00 per day.

Conference Room use only - \$40 per day.

### John Gray Lodge Lower Level

- includes use of Dining Hall, but not kitchen  
Heat/air, showers, catering kitchen. Sleeps 22.  
\$25.00 per person/night

**Cabins** - 10 Unheated cabins - Each accommodates 8  
\$20.00 per person/night

### **Cornelius Leadership Cabin** – Accommodates 3-4

Double bed and bunk beds, with own shower facilities  
Air Conditioned -\$40.00 per person/night.

### **Tamarack Lodge and Meeting Center** - Upper Level

Conference Room - \$195.00 per day

Catering kitchen included at no additional cost

### **Lower Level Tamarack**

- includes use of Upper Level meeting room  
S. Dormitory (18 bunks) & N. Dormitory (20 bunks)  
\$25.00 per person/night

### **Hyde Suite** - sleeps 3

Heat/Air, shower, refrigerator, microwave & coffee maker  
\$45.00 per person/night

### **Additional General Grounds Fees**

**Outdoor shelter rental** – depends on usage (\$25-\$75)

**Day fee**, includes waterfront usage (canoe/kayak/watercraft): \$10/day per person

Adjustments made at discretion of Camp Staff per availability and demand.

**NO LINENS PROVIDED** (Except at Basile for an additional fee)

The John Gray Kitchen is not available to rent for meals. Staff may be available to hire and we would work with you for options from our menu.

Approximate costs are:

Breakfast \$5

Lunch \$7

Dinner \$10

We do have catering kitchens available that include a refrigerator, microwave and small appliances like a toaster or rice cooker.

It is very important that any other appliances brought in like crock pots are in good working order and don't overload our electrical set ups. Please work with the Associate Regional Minister: Outdoor Ministries for your needs. If you are bringing in food/meals you may need to sign a waiver.

Food is not allowed in cabins unless cleared with the camp staff and stored in sealed containers.
